## 2018 Membership Information

Queensland Wind and Brass (QWAB) was formed in December 1989 and arose from a need for a high standard musical group for post-secondary musicians. The group consists of amateur and professional woodwind, brass and percussion players aged from 17 years upwards, and is run by the players themselves. Year 12 students are welcome to join QWAB.

QWAB plays a wide variety of music and has a schedule which includes formal and informal concerts. Formal concerts normally occur three times per year at the Old Museum Building, and informal concerts include performances at the Queen St Mall and joint performances with schools.

Application for membership is welcome from woodwind, brass and percussion players, however numbers are limited in each section. While QWAB is un-auditioned, it performs at a high standard, so a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 7 or equivalent is required.

New members will be subject to a trial period and may need to demonstrate their ability.
