Application for membership is welcome from woodwind, brass and percussion players, however numbers are limited in each section. While QWAB is un-auditioned, it performs at a high standard, so a **minimum standard of AMEB Grade 7 or equivalent is required.**

New members will be subject to a trial period and may need to demonstrate their ability.
